On December 28th, 1921, the first 55,000 H.P. unit of the Queenston-Chippawa Power Development was officially turned over with appropriate ceremonies in the presence of representatives of the Ontario Municipalities which are partners under the Hydro-Electric Power Commission of Ontario. This event celebrated the opening of the large Hydro-Electric Development commenced in 1917 after preliminary surveys and inquiries extending over a long period and the examination of suggestions for using the maximum head between Lake Erie and Lake Ontario dating back over twenty years. The plant will use over 300 feet of the 326 feet available fall and, therefore, represents a marked departure from the constructed power developments on the...
