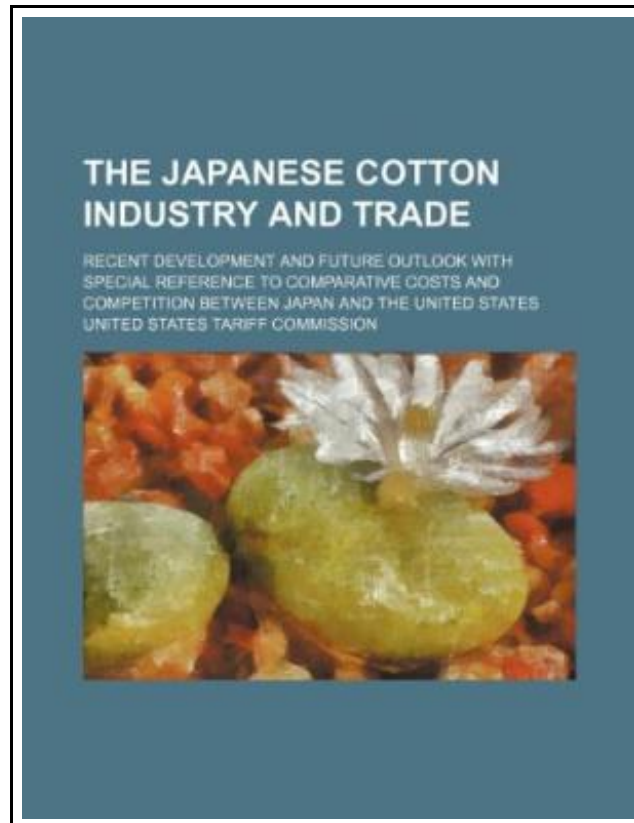

An important factor limiting the further extension of the Japanese spinning industry, has been the increasing difficulty during the past few years in recruiting a sufficient number of girls from the provinces to replace the constantly shifting workers, who are restless under the long hours and barrack life of the cotton mills. With the increased prosperity of the farmers and the opening up to women of new lines of work in the provincial districts, the spinning mills have found it increasingly difficult to replenish or extend their labor force. This force has hitherto been made up for the most part of young girls who are recruited from the country districts under a 3-year contract and who are required to live within the factory compound under conditions frequently crowded and insanitary and to work for long stretches, sometimes exceeding the nominal 12-hour shift.² Despite increases in wages, amounting by the end of 1919 to over three times the amounts earned prior to the war, the cost of labor had risen so high that manufacturers were forced to consider other measures to...
